CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

We are implementing a **Block Captain Program** and are looking for volunteers from each street in the community to serve as a **Block Captain** during emergencies. This is primarily a communication role and does **not** include duties beyond providing or collecting information.



As a Block Captain, you will:

- Serve as a point of contact for residents within your designated area
 - Act as a liaison between the residents and the Emergency Task Force.
 - Be equipped with information necessary for your role, as provided by the Emergency Task Force
- The Block Captain will also have the following responsibilities as we roll out the program:

- Introduce yourself to residents in your designated area and explain your role
- Facilitate in the distribution and collection of emergency contact forms, as provided by the Emergency Task Force
- Provide a list of units that are available to serve as a warming station to the Emergency Task Force
